

Lily of the Valley Easel Card

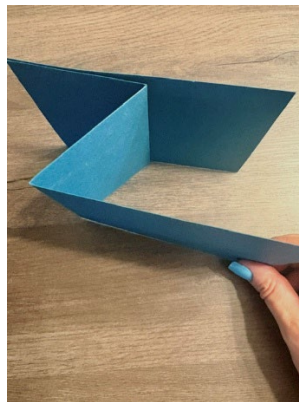
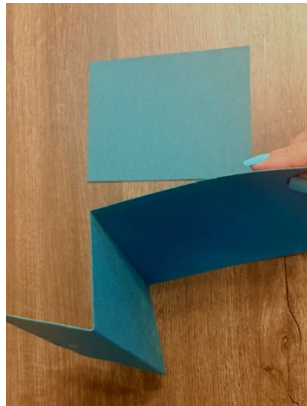


Cutting Directions:

- Pretty Peacock Card Base – 4 1/4" x 11", score at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2"
- Pretty Peacock 4 14" x 5 1/2"
- Valley in Bloom Designer Series Paper –("DSP") – 4" x 5 1/4" – cut 2
- Basic White – Scrap for arch, flower and circle
- Pretty Peacock – Scrap for arch and circle

Assembly:

- Fold on score lines so base resembles a "Z". Attach single Pretty Peacock panel to fold as shown



- Die cut Pretty Peacock and Basic White scrap pieces to create the nested arches and circles.

- On white arch and circle, very lightly blend Pretty Peacock to create soft color in the center. Use a water painter to splash water droplets over ink this will create some texture. Tap the pen on a blend so small drops come out. Pick up some ink in the cover of the Pretty Peacock with the water painter and again create small specks.



- Using VersaMark ink, stamp the small flower on a scrap Basic White and emboss with gold powder. Using Fresh Freesia and Granny Apple Green reinkers watercolor the leaves and flowers. Cut out with the coordinating die.
- Attach arch layers together and tie white baker's twine around bottom tying a bow. Add flower with dimensionals and stamp A Little Thanks using Pretty Peacock ink as shown. Attach to card front with dimensionals. Add butterfly gems in triangle pattern
- Stamp to a Forever Kind of Friend on white circle with Pretty Peacock ink add a few butterflies and attach to inside of card as shown.
