

Lily of the Valley Card #2

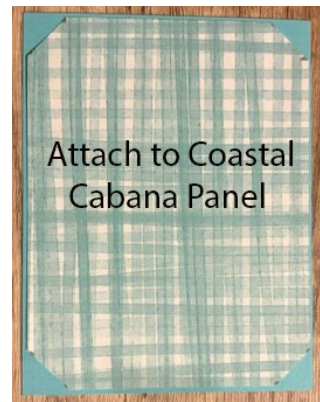


Cutting Directions:

- Basic White Card Base – 5 1/2” x 8 1/2”, score at 4 1/4”
- Coastal Cabana – 4 1/8” x 5 3/8”
- Coastal Cabana – 3 1/8” x 4 1/8”
- Plaid Designer Series Paper (“DSP”)– 4” x 5 1/4”
- Basic White – 3” x 4”
- Basic White – Scrap for greeting and lily flowers
- Granny Apple Green – Scrap for leaves & stem
- White Baker’s Twine approx. 6”
- Lily of the Valley bundle, Stylish Shapes dies
- Shimmering Dots

Directions and Assembly:

- Measure along each side of the plaid DSP **1/2”** and mark a small dot as shown in reference photo. Continue with this process on all sides, this will act as a guide for even corners.
- Cut from dot to dot, then adhere to Coastal Cabana piece. No need to measure this time, simply cut at the same angle as the plaid DSP. Repeat the process of cutting the corners after attaching this panel to the card base.



- On small white panel, VERY LIGHTLY add Coastal Cabana ink to the center only with the blending brushes. Make sure not to apply too much, you want a subtle amount of color.
- Get your water painter wet at the tip and tap on a pen. You will see little droplets form and create a distressed background. Repeat, using the Wink of Stella pen to add a bit of shimmer. See reference photo.



- Going back to how we did the corners for the card base, this time measure **1/4"** all the way around, cut from dot to dot. Then attach to small Coastal Cabana piece and cut corners. Attach to the center of the card base with dimensionals.
- Die cut the leaves and stem from scrap Granny Apple Green, die cut flowers and circle from scrap white.
- Wrap twine around the stem as shown and tie a bow.
- Glue to stem to the white panel, add leaves and white flowers. Using Granny Apple Green blends, color the top of each white flower, then go over with Wink of Stella. You can see detail in above reference photo
- Stamp greeting on white circle with Coastal Cabana ink, then adhere to card front with dimensionals.
- Add gems as shown
